

IMPACT TORPEDO—a missile with a warhead full of explosive material that explodes on impact.
INFINITY—[in-fin-ti] a ship. As of 6549, set aside to store all human knowledge on compu-tapes and books.
INSTRUCTIONAL PERIOD—a time set aside for the obtaining of knowledge.
INTER-COLONY BUS—the interplanetary transportation system.
IRIS CONE COUNT—an eye test.

JUDGMENT DAY—the mythical day, after death, when we meet our creator.

KELL—a cylon measurement.
KOBOL—[ko-ball] the home planet of humanity revisited in 6570. Now a dead world orbiting a pulsating star.
KRELL—[krel] an edible plant indigenous to most planets.
KRODEN—a small backward agro planet in the Cyranus galaxy that depends on the colonies for revenue.

LASER GENERATORS—[la-ser] a device that generates lasers for weapons.
LASER SCAPEL—a tiny hand held laser used to make incisions.
LASERONIC URGON TEST—[la-ser-on-ik-er-gon] a test to see the amount of energy expended by a laser.
LAXAR—[lacks-r] a unit of weight.
LIFE CENTER—medical section.
LIMITER—a device on starfighters that limits the power thrust of the turbo chargers.
LIVERY SHIP—ship used for raising animals.
LORDS OF KOBOL—the ancient rulers of man.
LUPUS—[lu-pus] a fur bearing quadruped predator found on the plains of Sectar, preying small rodents and the carcasses of larger animals.

MAGNA—a virtually indestructable metal.
MAGNETIC SEA—a term used to describe a void in space.
MATZEN—a measure of distance a little shorter than a kilometer.
MEGA-PRESSURE PUMPS—pumps capable of building a tremendous amount of pressure.
METRON—[me-tron] a measure of distance.
METRON BOMB—explosive devices.
MICRON—[mi-cron] 1/100th of a centon.
MILLA CENTON-1/1000th of a centon.
MOLECULAR BINDING PITON—a piton which molecularly attaches itself to rocks.

NEURO CELL—[nu-roh cell] brain cell.
NIGHT FLYER—a hawklike bird of prey with long sharp claws, preying on small rodents.
NOVA OF MADAGON—an extremely bright star field near the heart of the Cyranus galaxy, densely packed with small bright stars.

NUMO—a primitive hand weapon that used compressed gas to propel a small, usually metallic projectile.

OPPOSER—[o-pos-er] a person who knows, studies, or practices law.
OREGG—[o-reg] a heavy, precious metal that bends easily, and is yellowish orange in color in its pure form.
ORION—[o-ri-on] a planet in the Quotara system.
OVINE—[o-vine] a quadruped grazing animal raised for food.
OVINER—one who raises ovines.
OVIONS—[o-vi-ons] an intelligent burrowing insect race that are natural miners.

PENAL COLONY—small outpost prisons, usually placed on asteroids, used early in the war for prisoners the colonies could not support. Most of them were lost early in the war.

PETRO—[pe-tro] fuel refined from tylium.
PINIUS—[pih-nee-us] a planet.
PISCES—[py-seez] a ship, and a planet.
PLUTON—[plu-ton] a poisonous substance created by neutron fallout. It causes the molecular breakdown of consumables.

PRAESIDIUM—[prae-sid-e-um] central governing body of a planet, or group of planets.
PRECIPTUM LAYER—[pre-cip-tum] any mass of heavy element matter in deep space. It can be the result of natural processes such as the gravitational decay of an asteroid, or the waste product of certain types of primitive star drives.

PRIMARIES—[pri-mer-is] basic consumables.
PROTECTOR—[pro-tek-tor] see opposer.
PSYCHO ELECTRON RECALL—a scan of a persons subconscious memory to locate information.
PULSE GENERATOR—generating mechanism that propels spacecraft.
PYRAMID—[pir-a-mid] a game of chance played with cards.

QUORUM—[kwo-rum] a ruling body. The leaders of a planet or group of planets.
QUATRON—[ku-a-tron] a unit of currency.
QUOTARA—[kwo-ta-ra] a star cluster in the Cyranus galaxy containing seven red stars orbiting a blue star. Also a commercial starliner.

RADION—[ra-di-on] a form of radiation caused by the explosion of tylium.
RESPIRATORY PROBE—[res-pa-tor-e] a scan of a humanoid's breathing system.
RIGUS—[ri-jus] a planet.
RISING STAR—a commercial starliner.

SCANNER—a broad spectrum cybernetic antenna which receives all frequencies of radiation from a 360 degree sphere and feeds it into a computer for analysis.
