
3. The Black Sun Screenplay: DAVID WEIR

Maintenance engineer Ted Clifford becomes the pawn in an alien plot. As Clifford is repairing some equipment near a viewport, an energy beam flashes across the lunar horizon and strikes the Alphan's head. The beam, from a Triton Space Probe, leaves an energy implant in Clifford's brain. His brain now functions as an alien computer and everything he sees is transmitted back to the probe. Clifford then attempts to steal classified information from the Alphan computers. However, the implant was not properly placed and Clifford's brain "burns out." With the Alphan dead, a new target is selected -Helena Russell! She is transported aboard the Triton probe where she is given an energy implant at close range. But her brain will also "burn out" unless Koenig can stop the ship's inhabitants from carrying out their plot. Upon boarding the probe, though, Koenig discovers that Alpha's enemy is a machine. The Commander must outwit the alien logic of an automated spacecraft.
