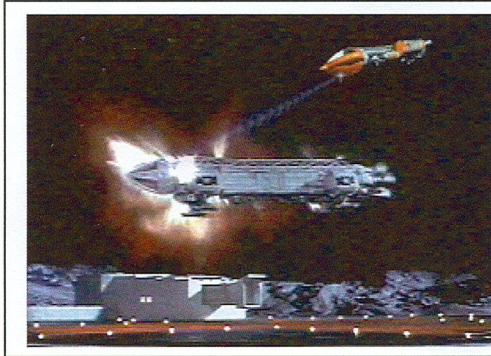

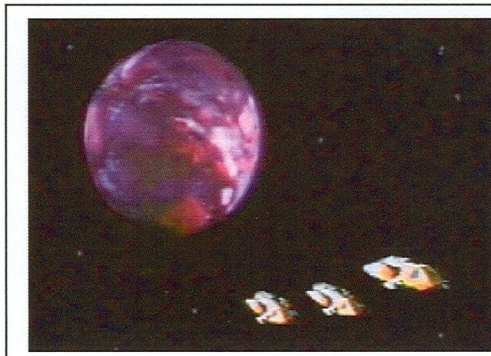
17. War Games

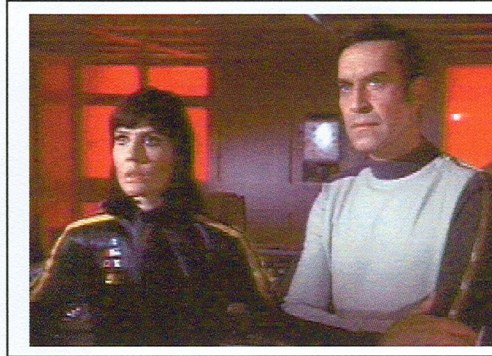
