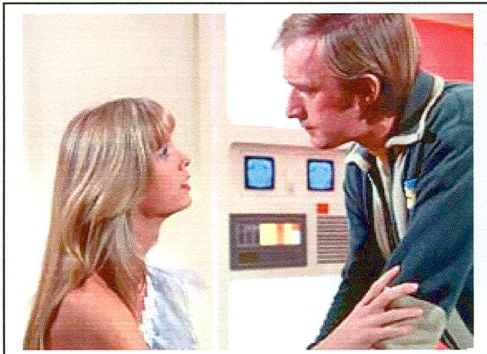
19. Dorzak

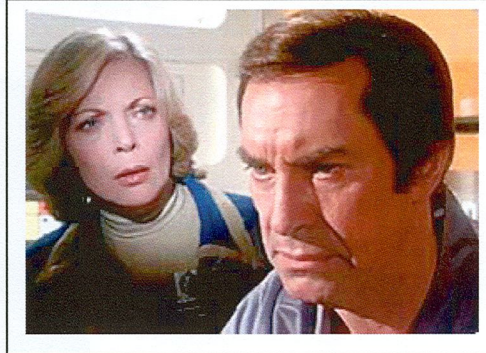
